9 am to 12 pm at the depot west of the market (Weather Permitting)


Every first Saturday: a free ride around the park.



Using your **SNAP** card at the market is easy.





Visit the Market Info Desk

Just come to the information desk and tell us how many SNAP dollar tokens you would like and your card will be swiped for that amount.



Purchase Market Tokens

You will receive both the SNAP tokens and an equal number (up to \$25) of Double Up match tokens. SNAP customers can get up to \$25 of free match tokens every market day.



Shop the Market

The \$1 SNAP tokens can be spent on any edible product, except hot food and food eaten on site. They can also buy edible plants and plants that produce food. The \$1 match tokens can only be spent on uncut fresh fruits and vegetables at the market. The vendors cannot give change for either the SNAP token or the match token but you can add change to come up with the right amount.

WIC Coupon Program

Families with WIC books can get two \$5 coupons once a week good for fresh produce, meat and eggs starting in June until funding runs out.

Free Meals for the Kids



May 26 through August 14 at the market Free kids meals, loaded with farm fresh fruits & veggies, every Tuesday (4:30 to 6:30 pm) and Thursday (11 am to 1 pm) and Saturday (9 to 11

am). Any child, ages 1 through 18, may eat.
