C. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER

Filling out Forms

- 1. This invitation to bid encompasses the furnishing of Type A school bus unit(s), for Economic Security Corporation. Because we anticipate purchasing stock buses, it is important for the bidder to indicate if general specifications are exceeded or if a variance exists. Comments regarding exceeded specifications, variances to specifications and additional equipment provided can be included in the box next to the specification and/or in the space provided immediately after the specification table.
- 2. All original bids must be submitted on the provided forms. Forms may be reproduced in full for submission of multiple bids.

1. GENERAL

- A. It is the purpose and intent of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) to purchase the Type A school buses listed herein for Economic Security Corporation of Southwest Area (ESC).
- B. The undersigned agrees to quote only on the items that can be delivered to the Economic Security Corporation in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this bid document.

2. QUOTATIONS

- A. Economic Security Corporation reserves the right to:
 - 1) Waive formalities and technicalities in any quotation.
 - 2) Reject any and/or all quotations wherein its judgment, it will be in the best interest of ESC.
 - 3) Accept the quotation that in its judgment will be in its best interest
 - 4) Purchase from any source, in part or in whole, any desired supplies, equipment or services.
 - 5) At its option, award on individual item(s) or on a lump sum basis.
 - 6) Award this bid to the vendor who in ESC's opinion is most responsive, responsible and will perform in the best interest of ESC.
- B. Price alone will not be the determining factor in award of this bid.
- C. Bids shall be firm for at least 60 days after bid opening.
- D. The supplier may give quotations on any one or more items and may offer alternates where indicated. No substitutes will be accepted once order is placed.
- 3. PRICES: Unit and total prices quoted shall include all charges to include, but not limited to, purchasing and delivery of the buses to Economic Security Corporation (ESC) North Joplin Head Start at 1200 North Main, Joplin MO 64801. ESC is exempt from State sales tax.
- 4. TRADE NAME: Suppliers are required to indicate brand name and model of buses and optional equipment quoted. Generally, brand names and models listed in the specifications are used as a standard of quality and are not meant to limit competition.
- 5. CONTRACT PERIOD: This is a one-time purchase.
- 6. RESPONSE, INTERPRETATION, AND COMMUNICATION: Response shall be on the bid forms provided only. If you do not wish to bid, respond with "No Bid" and give reason for this response.
- 7. DELIVERY: Delivery of all materials and equipment from this quotation shall be FOB destination to the address specified on the purchase order. Delivery shall be made within the vendor's quoted days after receipt of order. Immediate delivery is desired. Any item(s) not delivered within the time limit may be canceled by ESC at no expense to same.
- 8. INSPECTION: All buses shall be subject to inspection after arrival at destination. If any bus is found to be defective or otherwise not conforming to the specifications, ESC shall have the right to reject the bus and return it at the sellers' expense. Defects, unacceptable warranty service, or unacceptable availability of parts shall be corrected on a timely basis.
- 9. PAYMENT: Payment shall be made upon receipt, inspection, acceptance of the materials at destination and receipt of proper itemized invoices.
- 10. BID RECAP: A bid summary shall be sent to all participating vendors.
- 11. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY POLICY: Vendors shall abide by ESC's non-discrimination policy. The vendor/contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, veteran or disability status.
