Items For Approval:

Approval of November Meeting Minutes:A motion made by Crissy Belknap to approve the meeting minutes form last month. It was seconded by Walter Taylor. There were no objections, so the Item was approved.

Approval of Consent Agenda Items (Enrollment/Wailtists/Attendance Reports, Budgets, In-kind, New Hires): A motion was made by Chantelle Single to approve the Consent Agenda Items. It was seconded by Walter Taylor. There were no objections so the item was approved.

Approval of Revisions to the Safe Sleep Policy: Kandi Griffith, Health Coordinator, presented revisions to the safe Sleep policy. It was noted that the Missouri Law now requires programs who are serving infants to have a policy on safe sleep. The following changes were discussed:

- 1. Room temperatures must be between 68-85 degrees F, which is measured two feet from the floor.
- 2. Individually assigned, safety approved cribs or playpens with firm mattresses and tight fitting sheets are used for napping and sleeping.
- 3. Sitting devices are not used for sleeping. If a child falls asleep in a car seat, for example, they will be placed in a crib for the remainder of their sleep or nap time.
- 4. No toys or stuffed animals will be allowed inside the crib and pacifiers can not be attached to cords or attaching mechanisms.
- 5. Infants' heads and faces can not be covered, so cribs will not have blankets or bedding hanging on the sides of the crib.
- 6. Caregivers will receive in-person or online training on infant safe sleep within 30 days on employment or volunteering.
- 7. Parents and guardians will be informed of the facility's written safe sleep policy at enrollment
- 8. To promote healthy development, infants who are awake will be given supervised "tummy time" for exercise and play.

Board Liaison Report: Leisa Harnar, Head Start Director, presented the Board Report. Items that were discussed at the Board meeting were reviewed- Director's reports and Committee reports. Some of the results from a recent Agency Customer Satisfaction Survey were shared. It was noted that 100% of customers stated they were satisfied with services provided.

<u>Head Start Director's Report:</u> Leisa Harnar Presented the following items:

- 1. 4 Centers (NJHS, SJHS, SJEHS, Sarcoxie) are approved for the advanced level of Missouri Move Smart through the Dept. Of Social Services.
- 2. We will be participating in a program, Asthma Ready, Through the Dept and Health and Human Services and the CDC. This program will supply special kits for families with children who have asthma and it will provide training to staff and families on ways to promote each child's health.
- 3. We are back to family style meals and toothbrushing at the centers.
- 4. Due to Illness of staff and children, we have begun a shortened week that started on 1/18/22 and may continue until 2/18/22 unless we see the absentee rates decrease.
- 5. OHS vaccine and mask mandates have temporary injunction against it, so until further notice, that is on pause. Our Agency policy regarding vaccines is also on pause for now.
- 6. We are still requiring masks for adults and everyone on the buses.
- 7. Children are not wearing masks other than on the bus, unless it is requested by a parent.
- 8. All sites have been disinfected with Lumaclean.
- 9. We are enforcing ventilation on buses and in classrooms through open windows and air purifiers





HHS Poverty Guidelines for 2022

On behalf of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation has prepared <u>new poverty guidelines</u>. Many programs across the federal government, as well as state governments and nonprofit organizations, rely on these guidelines to determine family eligibility for systems and services. The 2022 poverty guidelines are calculated by taking the 2020 Census Bureau's poverty thresholds and adjusting them for price changes between 2020 and 2021 using the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U).

Helping Families Access 2021 Tax Credits and Stimulus Payments

Many families are continuing to struggle financially due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The federal <u>Earned Income</u> <u>Tax Credit (EITC)</u> and <u>Child Tax Credit</u> are among the largest Internal Revenue Service (IRS) public benefits for low-income households. Head Start, Early Head Start, and other early child care and education staff can ensure families are informed about all available tax credits.



The resources below help families understand tax credits and special rules around the third **Economic Impact Payments** (stimulus checks) issued in March 2021. Learn about eligibility requirements and how to access these benefits, including free tax preparation services.

The American Rescue Plan's Impact on 2021 Taxes

The American Rescue Plan for 2021 allows taxpayers to use their earned income from tax year 2019 or 2020, if it was higher than their 2021 income to determine the amount of benefits, they will receive from the EITC and the refundable portion of the Child Tax Credit in the 2021 tax year. This special rule will help families this year who experienced lower wages receive a larger refund that is consistent with their earnings from prior filing seasons due to the pandemic.

EITC

EITC is a benefit for workers with low and moderate income. To qualify, an individual must meet specific requirements and file a tax return. If a family owes taxes, EITC can reduce

the amount they owe. In other instances, EITC may provide a refund. Individuals must file a tax return and claim the tax credit to receive it.

Jan. 28 Is EITC Awareness Day!

Join a national effort to <u>increase awareness</u> about refundable credits. Find <u>marketing</u> and <u>communication materials</u> you can use to spread the word to ensure families don't miss out on eligible benefits.

The maximum amount of credit an individual can receive for tax year 2021 is:

- \$6,728 with three or more qualifying children
- \$5,980 with two qualifying children
- \$3,618 with one qualifying child

Child Tax Credit and Credit for Other Dependent

The refundable Child Tax Credit may reduce a family's taxes by as much as \$3,600 for each qualifying child. Families can receive the entire tax credit for each qualifying child as the Additional Child Tax Credit even if they aren't required to file a tax return or they don't owe any taxes. Many families received half of their Child Tax Credits via monthly payments from July to December 2021. All families can receive the remaining half of the Child Tax Credit that they are owed by filing their 2021 taxes, or the full amount if they didn't get monthly payments.

Families with dependents who don't qualify for the Child Tax Credit, may be able to claim the <u>Credit for Other Dependents</u>. The maximum credit amount is \$500 for each dependent who meets certain conditions.

Economic Impact Payments (Stimulus Checks)

Let families know that the stimulus money received in 2021 is not considered taxable income. Families can learn more about stimulus payments and how to reconcile their 2021 Tax Return on the IRS website. Families can also visit the IRS website to track their payments.



Recovery Rebate Credit

The Recovery Rebate Credit is a tax credit authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and the COVID-19-related Tax Relief Act. Individuals are eligible if they did not receive the full amounts of the third stimulus payment in March 2021. An individual's 2021 income tax is used to determine the amount of the Recovery Rebate Credit. If eligible, this credit can increase a tax refund or decrease the amount of tax owed. Visit the IRS website to learn more about <u>eligibility requirements</u>.

Free Tax Services

The <u>Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)</u> program offers free tax help to people who make \$57,000 or less, persons with disabilities, and limited English-speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their tax returns. Families can usually find VITA sites in community and neighborhood centers, libraries, schools, shopping malls, and other convenient locations. However, due to COVID-19, many VITA sites are closed or have switched to virtual tax return preparation for an undetermined period. To locate an open site near you, use the <u>VITA Locator Tool</u> or call (toll-free) 888-227-7669.

The <u>IRS Free File</u> offers many online resources and tax help. Find tax forms, instructions and publications, online payment options, and more. Individuals can even prepare and file their federal income tax online for free.
