## Head Start Prenatal – 5 Program Policy Council Meeting

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**Call to Order:** Leisa Harnar, Head Start Director, called the meeting to order at 6:33 PM.

**Roll call:** Ashley Dickenson, Family Engagement Specialist

### **Item For Approval:**

#### **1. Approval of April's Meeting Minutes and Consent Agenda Items**

**(Enrollment/Waitlists/Attendance Reports, Budgets, In-kind, New Hires):** A motion was made by Chantelle Single to approve the Consent Agenda Items. It was seconded by Brittany Combs. There were no objections so the motion was approved.

**2. Approval of New Fiscal Director:** John Joines, CEO of ESCSWA, Presented David Cusack for approval as the Fiscal Director for ESCSWA. Mr. Joines shared information about Mr. Cusack's background and qualifications. Chantelle Single made a motion to approve David Cusack for the position of Fiscal Director. The Motion was seconded by Brittany Combs. There were no objections. The motion was approved.

### **Items For Review:**

1. **Review of Parent Survey:** Kelly Creech, Family Engagement Coordinator, presented results from the Parent survey from this year. Some of the items that she shared were:
  - \*Only 26% of parents said that they had gotten behind on bill/utilities due to Covid
  - \*97% of families felt their parenting skills and knowledge improved
  - \*98% of families feel valued, supported and respected by their staff. 99% feel their center is healthy, safe, and welcoming
  - \*67% of families did not attend Conscious Discipline Classes
  - \*67% of families did not use VROOM App or text messages. Over 50% who responded did not know about it.
2. **School Readiness Report (Head Start):** Cindy Ladbasri, HS Education Coordinator, shared the End of the year assessments for the Head Start program. Results indicated we did not meet our goal of 90% in all developmental domains. Cindy stated we started the year under-enrolled and were not fully enrolled until January 2022. She stated many children also missed several days due to COVID related illness in their family. Cindy shared that teachers have been identified that will need more assistance in ensuring children reach their developmental milestones and those teachers will have additional support from the Education team.

**Board Liaison Report:** Leisa Harnar Shared information from the May 5, 2022 Agency Board Meeting.

**Item For Approval:**

**1. Approval of The Self Assessment:** Leisa Harnar presented the results of the 21-22 Self Assessment. Short-term and Long-term goals from the improvement plan were reviewed. Motion was made by Chantell Single to approve the Self-Assessment and a second was made by Brittany Combs. No one was opposed so the motion was approved.

Leisa asked that 2 items be removed from the Agenda, Approval of the Grievance Policy and Approval of the Impasse policy as both policies were reviewed during Policy Council training at the September PC meeting. The policies are included in the PC Representatives' manuals.

**Director's Report:**

Head Start:

1. Preparing for Fall pre-service training for new and returning staff.
2. Several staff are attending training on Health, Nutrition, Conscious Discipline, Disabilities, and Employee Wellness.
3. Many renovations at our centers this Summer.
4. Workforce Investment Board MOU- Develop partnerships to develop family child care with local Afghani families who recently immigrated to Webb City and Carl Junction. We will provide CDA classes and assistance with licensing.
5. The 2022-2023 calendar has been completed. More closed days for EHS Center-based staff, Spring breaks to coincide with school districts, 2 employee wellness days.
6. The Office of Head Start has directed us to use American Rescue Plan funds for employee retention incentives.
7. Two parents are registered to participate in child care feedback groups facilitated by the Dept. Of Education and Mo. Head Start Association.
8. Some of our staff are assisting another Head Start Program OACAC to improve their monitoring. The HS Director said she had heard we did a great job with the monitoring suite.

EHS:

1. No finding in our EHS State Monitoring.
2. Revamping EHS Services to improve employee retention, increase school readiness, and improve our classroom assessments
3. Footprints and Friends Too gave notice to end their contract with our program as of July 22. We are looking for a new partnership for 8 infants and toddlers.
4. We have had an increase in COVID cases among our staff so we reinstated the 10am and 2 pm classroom cleanings at EHS. Staff have been directed to take children outside in the mornings and increase ventilation in the building- including running air purifiers.
5. We will be closed the week of July 4-8 in all EHS classrooms. Our partners will be open.

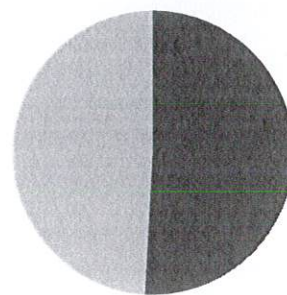

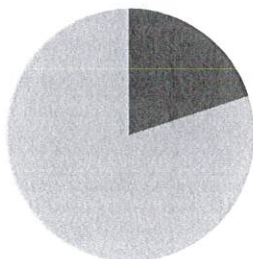

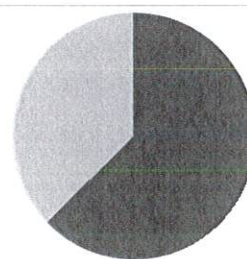

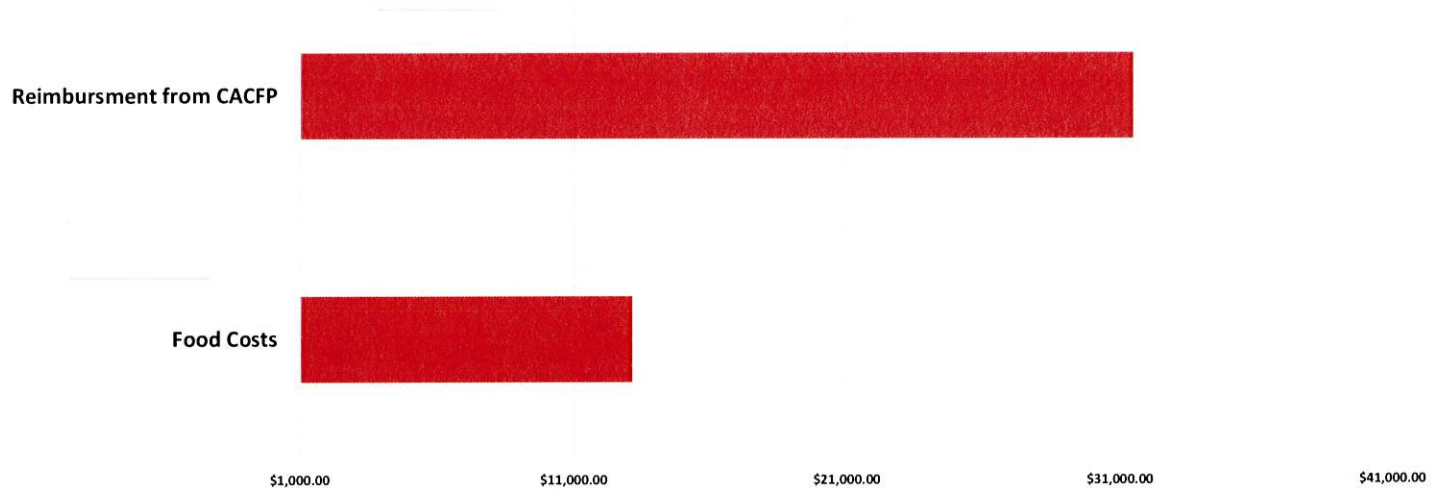

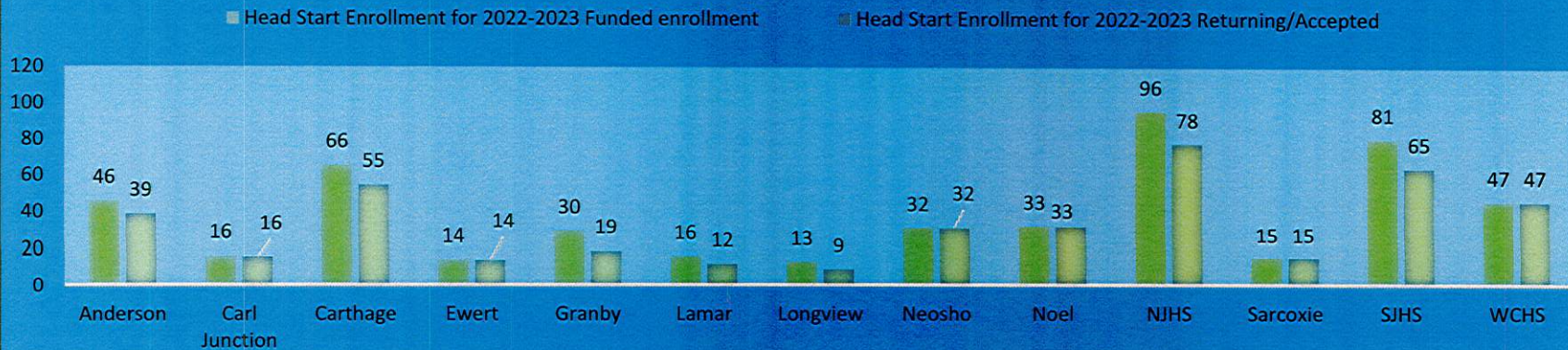

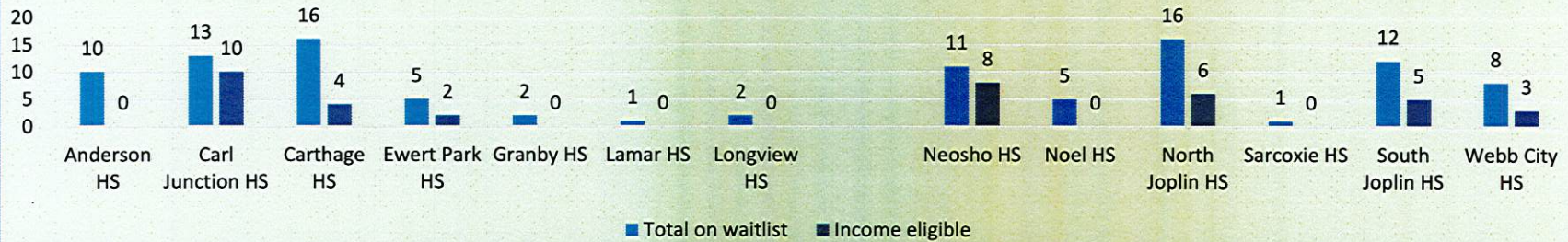

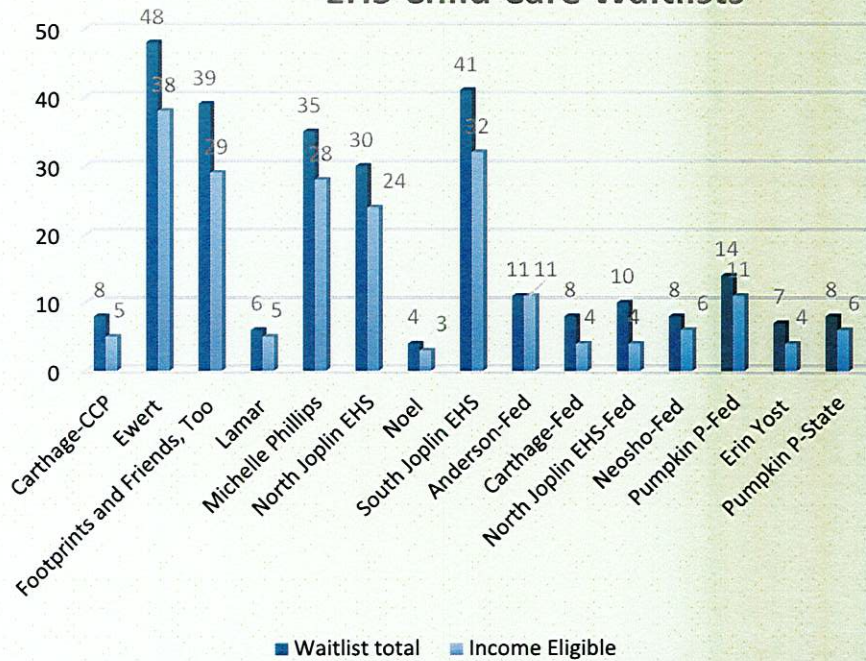

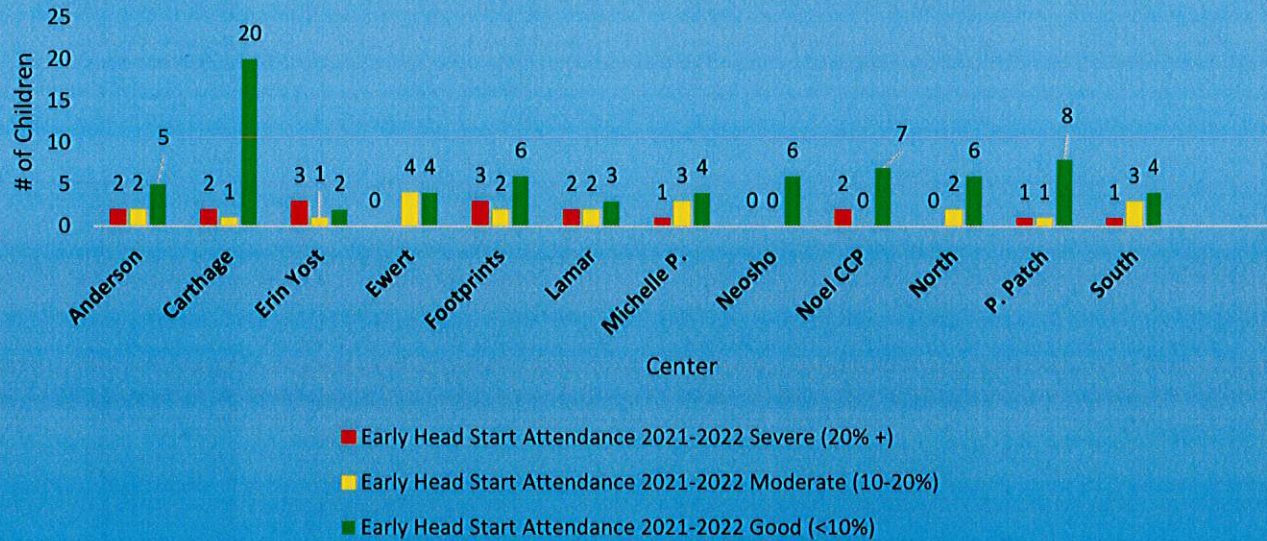
