Call to Order: Crissy Belnap, Policy Council Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:32 PM.

Items For Approval:

- Approval of March Meeting Minutes and Consent Agenda (Enrollment, Waitlist, and Attendance Reports; Budget Reports, CACFP report, Credit Card Report, OHS Correspondence; New Hires) Sent out earlier this month. A motion was made by Walter Taylor and seconded by Harley Leake. No objections were made- the motion passed.
- 2. Revision to Selection Criteria to add points for prenatal applications when the applicant is in the first and second trimester of pregnancy- Amy Schmidt. A motion was made by Walter Taylor and seconded by Crissy Belnap. No objections were made. The motion passed.
- ChildCare Partnership Grant Application: Leisa Harnar presented a review of the EHS ChildCare Partnership Grant and asked for approval to submit our application in the amount of \$1,667,921.
 A motion to approve the grant application was made by Michelle Burge and seconded by Walter Taylor
- 4. Bylaw approval (2nd reading)- Leisa Harnar reviewed the Bylaws and answered questions. A request for approval was made. Motion to approve was made by Crissy Belknap and seconded by Walter Taylor. No objections were made. The motion was approved.
- 5. A request to approve the application for a 2.28% cost of living increase for Head Start and Early Head Start was made in the following amounts: Head Start \$158,332, Early Head Start \$36,673, and Early Head Start CCP \$37,185. A motion to approve the application was made by Crissy Belknap and seconded by Walter Taylor. There were no objections. The motion passed.
- 6. A request was made to approve an application for Quality Improvement Funds for Head Start and Early Head Start in the following amounts: Head Start \$38,624, Early Head Start \$9,780, and Early Head Start CCP \$10,000. The motion to approve the application was made by Michelle Burge and seconded by Crissy Belknap. There were no objections. The motion passed.

Presentation:

- Tony Wright, Fiscal Director presented a training on Budget Basics and Conflicts of Interest for the Policy Council members.
- 2. Kathy Miller, Assistant Director, shared the F.A.C.E. (Funding Assistance for Continuing Education) report. Kathy shared that this funding is available to all Head Start Prenatal-5 employees. This year F.A.C.E. money has paid for 7 CDA renewals, 2 initial CDAs, and Weekly CDA classes on site at ESC. Kathy also mentioned that this year we have hired 15 parents this year in Head Start/Early Head Start that are now eligible for this funding to further their education.

Head Start Director's Report: Leisa Harnar presented the following items:

- 1. April 15 Staff Wellness day was a success! Staff gave great feedback from the event and requested we do this again.
- 2. Kindergarten visits are starting for our 4 year olds who will be leaving us in the Fall.
- 3. Parent Events at our centers are in full swing.
- Parent surveys have been distributed to families and our goal is to get 325 back. We have 1
 more week to collect the surveys.
- 5. We have open position at Lamar EHS, Carl Junction, South Joplin, and Carthage
- 6. Jeff Goldammer, our former HS Director received the MHSA Tom Mayer Award of Excellence. Some staff will be attending a banquet to honor him on May 12th in Jefferson City.
- 7. We are making many improvements to our Head Start buildings painting, landscaping, signage, etc. Leisa will plan to share photos next month- more work is planned for the summer.
- 8. The Mask Mandate on public transportation ended on 4/18/22, so we are not requiring masks to be worn on the buses any longer.
- 9. We have had and have scheduled several trainings for employees and parents recently including: ChildPlus, CACFP, Inclusion Institute, Employee Wellness Institute, Child and Family Health and Fitness program, Family Engagement Best Practices, and ABC's of Asthma.







IMPASSE RESOLUTION POLICY FOR HEAD START AND EARLY HEAD START

Policy Number: AD9901-07	Effective Date: 3/17/99
Policy Council Approval Date: 3/17/99	ESC Board Approval Date: 3/4/99

<u>PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE</u>: In accordance with 45CFR 1301.6, the Grantee Governing Body and Policy Council jointly must establish written procedures for resolving internal disputes between the governing body and the policy group.

<u>SUMMARY:</u> In the event of an unresolved dispute between the Agency Board of Directors and the Head Start Policy Council, the approved impasse resolution process will be followed. Respect, courtesy and patience must be practiced by all involved parties to ensure that an agreeable solution to the issue is reached.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES::

Section 1. General Procedures. Open communication between both groups will be facilitated by reviewing actionable agenda items, sharing of minutes and staff reports. In addition, the Head Start Policy Council will include a member of the Agency Board of Directors and the Agency Board of Directors will include a member of the Head Start Policy Council.

Section 2. <u>Informal Processes</u>. If an unresolved dispute occurs, the following informal processes will be utilized to attempt resolution of the issue:

- a. The Chief Executive Officer and the Head Start Director will jointly prepare a written statement outlining the dispute and ensure that each group reviews the document and has an opportunity to ask questions and seek clarification.
- b. If the impasse is not resolved through this process, the next step will be a meeting of the Chief Executive Officer, Head Start Director, Policy Council Chair and Agency Board Chair. in an attempt to resolve the impasse.
- c. These informal processes must occur within 45 days unless both parties agree to an extension.

Section 3. Formal Processes. If the informal processes do not resolve the conflict within the specified time, the CEO and Head Start Director will prepare a list of disinterested 3rd party mediators. The Board of Directors and the Policy Council will select a mutually agreeable mediator from the list and participate in a formal process of mediation that leads to a resolution of the dispute.

- a. Disinterested parties must not include any parents or family members of children currently enrolled in the Head Start program, and any staff or board members of the Grantee Agency or Head Start program.
- b. Examples of a 3rd party mediator could include attorneys, elected officials, clergy or counselors, business executives, etc.
- c. If no resolution is reached with a mediator, the Board of Directors and the Policy Council will enter into binding arbitration with a mutually agreeable arbitrator. The decision of the arbitrator will be final pending approval of the funding source.

AGENCY GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE FOR HEAD START COMPLAINTS

Policy Number: AD9409	Effective Date: June 17, 2009
Policy Council Approval Date: June 17, 2009	ESC Board Approval Date: May 4, 2009

PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: The grievance procedure is a problem-solving mechanism in which every attempt is made to resolve issues at the lowest level of authority, with the least possible amount of program disturbance. The Economic Security Corporation Board of Directors and Policy Council have established this system to resolve complaints quickly, fairly, and informally in order to devote maximum time, resources, and energy to our mission. This system does not entitle anyone to continued services, specific resolution, or provision of a specific request or desire. Instead, it is intended to enhance communication, preserve relationships, and to resolve differences in a confidential, non-adversarial setting. (Head Start Performance Standard 45 CFR Section 1305.50)

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE:

- 1. When a parent or member of the community brings a concern to a staff person, they must immediately begin efforts to understand and informally resolve the concern. The staff person must complete a contact note detailing the efforts and results. All documentation will be forwarded and filed in the Central Office.
- Failing resolution at that level, the person with the complaint may bring the concern to the next appropriate supervisor. Telephone calls, meetings, email and other communication will be used to resolve problems or concerns at the center level.
- 3. If the informal discussion process does not lead to a satisfactory outcome, the person with the complaint may file a formal grievance by using the agency form or by providing the Head Start Director with: 1) a statement identifying the concern, 2) an outline of the facts surrounding the grievance, and 3) the remedy requested.
- 4. The Head Start Director will investigate the matter and make a decision within 5 days.
- 5. If the decision of the Head Start Director is not satisfactory, it may be appealed to the Agency Chief Executive Officer by sending or mailing the agency form or the written statement described above to: ESC CEO, 302 Joplin St, Joplin, MO 64801.
- The Agency Chief Executive Officer will review the matter and will give a response within ten working days.
- 7. If the finding is appealed to the Agency Board of Directors, the Board (or a standing committee of the Board) has a maximum of thirty working days to review the matter. If the Agency Board determines that this grievance procedure was followed, the matter is closed as far as the Agency is concerned and the recommendation of the Agency Chief Executive Officer shall remain in effect.
- 8. Anonymous complaints will not be accepted.
- Grievances alleging criminal acts or immediate danger to children are dealt with immediately by program officials, parents, and other authorities as appropriate.
- 10. Each staff person involved must complete a contact note detailing the efforts and results of the investigation process. All documentation will be forwarded to the Operations and Development Director in the Central Office.
- 11. The hierarchy of authority to resolve parent and/or community grievances is as follows:
 - 1. Originator (parent or community person) and staff person.
 - 2. Area Supervisor and Coordinator (if applicable).
 - 4. Head Start Director.
 - 5. Agency Chief Executive Officer.
 - 6. Agency's Board of Directors (or Grievance Committee).
