Call to Order: Leisa Harnar, Head Start Director, called the meeting to order at 6:40 PM.

Opening Icebreaker: Kelly Creech lead Policy Council Reps in an Ice breaker/ Team building activity.

PC Appreciation: Leisa and Kathy presented gifts and cards in appreciation for dedication to this year's PC Reps.

Approval of Consent Agenda July Policy Council Minutes, Enrollment, Waitlist, and Attendance Reports; Budget Reports, CACFP report, Credit Card Report, OHS Correspondence and New Hires: Motion to approve made by Terrah Ingram; Seconded by Michelle Burge. Motion was approved.

Approval of Fiscal Director: John Joines, ESC CEO, presented William "Bill" Chase for the position of Fiscal Director. John shared Mr. Chase's qualifications and answered questions from the members. A motion to approve William "Bill" Chase for the Fiscal Director was made by Terrah Ingram and seconded by Michelle Burge. The motion passed.

Approval of Communicable Disease Policy: Kandi Griffith, Health Services Coordinator presented changes to the Communicable Disease Policy. A motion to approve was made by Michelle Burge and seconded by Crissy Belknap. The motion was approved

Approval of Accident and Injury Policy: Kandi Griffith, Health Services Coordinator presented the Accident and Injury Policy. A motion to approve was made by Michelle Burge and seconded by Terrah Ingram. The motion was approved.

Approval of CRSSA Budget Revision: Leisa Harnar presented a revision to the CRSSA budget to include "Personnel" costs and a reduction to the "Other" category in order to charge costs to the personnel category. A motion to approve the budget revision was made by Terrah Ingram and seconded by Crissy Belknap. The motion was passed.

Presentation of ERSEA Updates: Leisa Harnar presented updated information on Enrollment numbers for this program year. We are currently at 502 out of 505 for Head Start enrollment and all other programs are fully enrolled.

Director's Report: Leisa Harnar gave a report to update on program activities:

First Day of Extended Day classes 8/17, Anderson started on 8/22 due to roof construction and North Joplin plans to start on 8/29 due to bathroom additions and required inspections.

First Day of Head Start classes were 8/23

Lamar Head Start – bollards installed by Crossland Construction at no charge to the program, will still have to add a fenced walkway to the playground and we will most likely build a new parking lot because the walkway will cut our parking lot into 2 sections.

There has been some theft at our centers recently: gates at Ewert were stolen, catalytic converters at SJHS were stolen – cameras and lighting will be installed at all centers/sites

Retention & Onboarding process – Kathy Miller has been interviewing groups of new teachers and aides, we recently completed a new Onboarding video to show new employees, we purchased items for new employees (t-shirts and cups) and have continued \$1000 sign on bonuses, we are participating in MSSU's Community Day to recruit new employees and volunteers, Area Supervisors will be focusing on new employees and retention activities for all current staff, September we will start retention payments for current employees, we will hold our next Employee Wellness Day on September 26, and currently 7 employees have taken advantage of either reduced days, working from home, or changed daily hours

Leisa asked Kelly Creech to share information about the Conscious Discipline Parenting Classes that will be starting soon. Everyone is looking forward to this new approach this year

Farm to Table practices – new funded initiative by USDA. Our Nutrition Coordinator will be partnering with local farmers to provide fresh fruits and vegetables as part of our menu and meal service in our classrooms.

Closing announcements -

There was a discussion regarding the playground at Neosho Head Start. Crissy Belknap stated staff would like to get rid of the gravel. Leisa shared that the current playground has appropriate and approved resilient material. It is a large playground with gravel under swings, a large pour in play resilient material area, and lots of grass for gross motor play. Leisa shared that funds had been spent on other more pressing issues at the center this year. It has undergone numerous new changes including new bathrooms in the classrooms, new desks & chairs, painting, renovation to the Teachers' office, and new landscaping. In addition, they will be getting new carpet, a new staff refrigerator, the EHS side will be getting a new playground and new siding installed on the outside of the EHS building.

Leisa mentioned that next month's meeting will be with new members as it's the beginning of the program year.
