Economic Security Corporation of Southwest Area's Summer Energy Crisis Intervention Program

The Missouri Department of Social Services has released its Summer Cooling assistance services to provide payment assistance for low-income Missourians with their summer cooling bills if they are in crisis.

There are some changes to the Summer Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

Summer Crisis Intervention Program:

• Meet 60% of the State of Missouri's SMI income level (chart below) for Missourians to income qualify.

To Be Eligible for the Summer Cooling Program:

- Meet or be below 60% of Missouri's SMI guidelines, and
- Must have a shut-off notice or services been terminated, and
- Be responsible for paying home cooling bill, and
- Have less than \$3,000 in bank accounts, retirement accounts or investments, and
- Be a U.S. citizen or legally admitted for permanent residents.
