SUMMARY

The Weatherization Technician performs basic tasks necessary to weatherizing houses.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Operates insulation machinery to insulate homes.
- 2. Uses various skilled tools such as skill saws, jigsaws, routers, and cordless/electrical drills to perform weatherization duties.
- 3. Installs insulation in attics, walls, and under floors.
- 4. Repairs existing doors, windows, foundations, roofs, and siding.
- 5. Responsible for basic weatherization to houses such as insulating, caulking, and weather stripping.
- 6. Responsible for maintenance and care of tools.
- 7. Performs air tests on houses with blower door machine.
- 8. Assists in the loading of materials for each job.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Less than high school education, and up to six months related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals. Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to fumes or airborne particles, extreme cold, and extreme heat. The employee is frequently exposed to moving mechanical parts; high, precarious places; and outside weather conditions. The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions and risk of electrical shock. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
